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| <p>Outcomes</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gaps between disadvantaged pupils and their peers reduce. • Identified (recent arrivals, arrivals after reception and hard to reach) children make accelerated progress so their achievement is in line with peers. • Pupils with SEND make at least expected progress in relation to their provision plan. |
| <p>Quality of Education</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The school's curriculum will provide opportunities for children to recognise and celebrate the diversity and strengths of themselves, their school and the wider community. |
| <p>Behaviour, attitudes and personal development</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pupils contribute to specific policies and practice linked to behaviour, attitudes and personal development. • Pupil voice is established and provides the children of the school with a clear voice on a range of issues and mandates. • The school gathers the views and opinions from all key groups across the school. |
| <p>Leadership</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School leaders will ensure that the school is operationally effective and financially stable so that outcomes for all pupils including key groups continues to improve. • School leaders will ensure that the integrity of the school vision and ethos is maintained so that rights of all members of the school community (with regard to protected characteristics) are upheld. |

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
