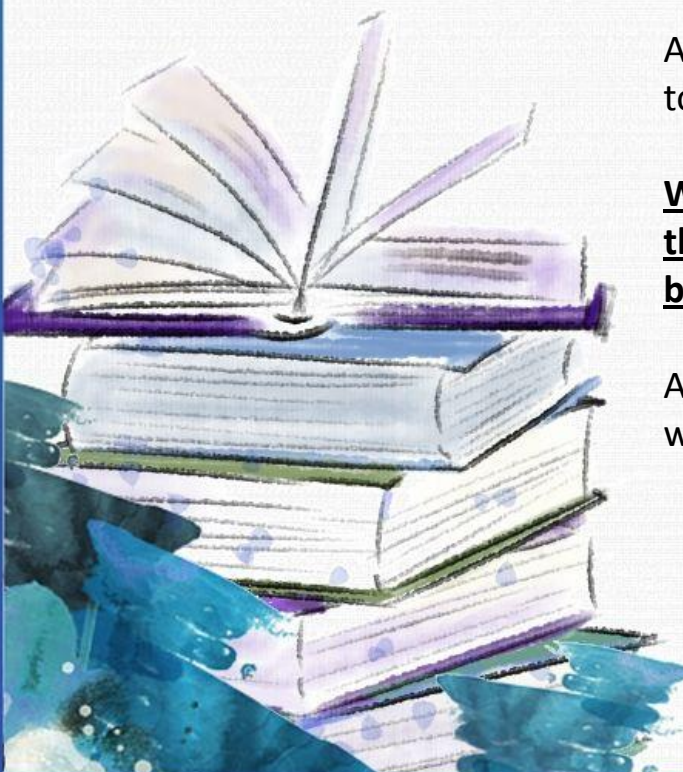
# How this booklet works
