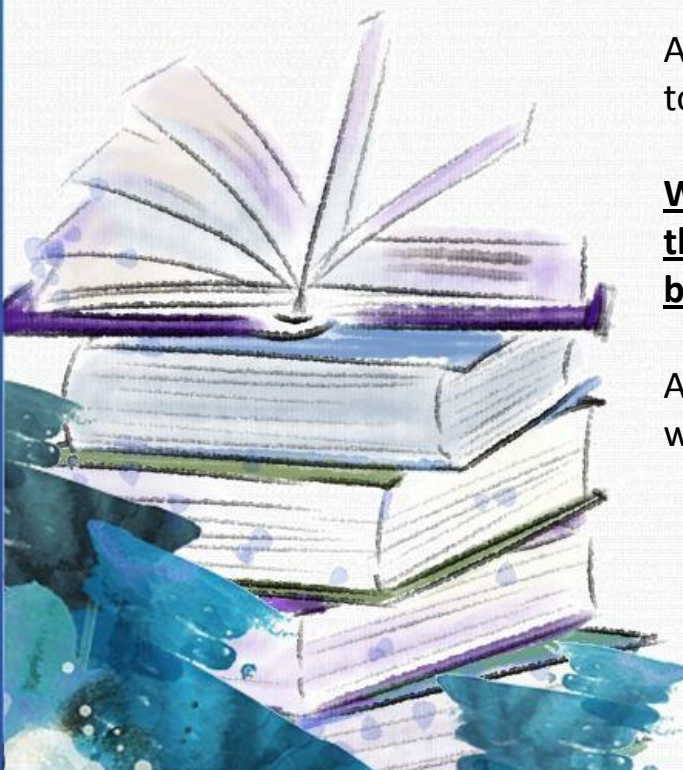
Have a go at completing as many of these reading challenges as possible.
